### Government Funding

The government provide Early Years Funding. This comes into place the term after the child's 3rd birthday. Government funding is intended to deliver 15/30 hours a week term time (-reduced hours per week if spreading the entitlement to cover holidays) of free, high quality, flexible, childcare. It is not intended to cover the cost of meals, consumables or additional hours.

15 hours funding is applicable to all children upon completion of a funding form, returned to the setting. To receive the additional 15 hours (30 hours total), you need to apply online to see if you meet the criteria. Both parents working 16 hours per week or more and below an income threshold.

#### **3-year-old Funding**

A child born in the period	Will be eligible for a free place
1 <sup>st</sup> April – 31 <sup>st</sup> August	1 <sup>st</sup> Sept following the child's 3 <sup>rd</sup> birthday (Autumn term)
1 <sup>st</sup> Sept – 31 <sup>st</sup> Dec	1 <sup>st</sup> Jan following the child's 3 <sup>rd</sup> birthday (Spring term)
1 <sup>st</sup> Jan – 31 <sup>st</sup> Mar	1 <sup>st</sup> April following the child's 3 <sup>rd</sup> birthday (Summer term)

## **2-year-old Funding**

We also accept two-year-old funding. Children and families need to meet a certain criterion to qualify within this scheme.

The entitlement is offered free. Parents will not be charged a “top-up” fee to recoup the difference between the amount received from the Local Authority and the current hourly rate, but any additional hours attended over funding entitlement will be charged for as well as consumables.

Additional hours will be charged according to the following table:

<b>Age Group</b>	<b>Actual Hourly Rate</b>
2-3 Years	7.00
3-4 Years	6.87

There will also be a daily consumable charge billed according to the following table:
