



CAS applications

If we have spaces, Westbury House School is happy to accept applications from children living abroad who need a visa (CAS) in order to study in England.

In order to facilitate this process, there are a number of extra requirements as directed by the United Kingdom government. They can be found using the following link <https://www.gov.uk/child-study-visa/overview> .

We are bound by these processes and the time it takes the government agencies to complete the registration process.

In the event of a child being offered a place under this procedure, the registration fee of £100 applies when seeking a place. If a place is offered, the deposit of £750 and the first term's fees are required to secure a place for a child. There is also a one-off non-refundable fee of £500 towards the cost of obtaining the CAS. This covers the school's costs in obtaining the CAS and maintaining the school as an establishment that can offer this provision.
